Introduction

As part of regular admission forms done at the beginning of each year or when enrolling, you signed an Acceptable User Policy regarding your student's right to access the internet. Throughout the year, your student creates work and does projects, some of which may be suitable to put on the internet. We want to take this opportunity to inform you of your rights, what you may see on the internet regarding your child, and allow you to decide whether this is acceptable for your family.

Publishing Student Work to the World Wide Web (Internet)

Your student's work may be considered for publication on the internet, specifically on his/her school's web site. Such publishing requires parent/guardian permission. The work will appear with a copyright notice prohibiting the copying of such work without express written permission. In the event anyone requests such permission, those requests will be forwarded to the student's parent/guardian.

- **Student Photographs** are always unidentified photos of students which may be published on school websites, illustrating student projects and achievements.
- **Podcasts** and **WebQuests** are created as class projects. Students collect images and facts about a topic studied in class. Sometimes, students also use a video camera – perhaps they read a poem or script they have written. This is then turned into a movie or website that can be added to the internet so others can learn from your student's experience.
- **Blogs** are opportunities for students to exchange information with other BISD students in a safe environment. BISD ONLY uses secure blog sites for students. ALL PERSONS blogging are staff and BISD students who have been approved by our staff. Blogs are used to introduce students to safe online habits, a unique way to study, and a place to discuss issues which are led by staff members.
